

College Requirements

1. Please read all requirements carefully!
2. Entrant must have lived within the Albert Lea Civic Music selling area, (i.e. – approximately 30 mile radius).
2. Entrant must be a current freshman, sophomore, or junior in college actively participating in music classes/musical activities.
3. Instrumental requirements:
 - a. any movement of a concerto or representative piece
 - b. a contrasting piece from a different composer and time period than above.
4. Vocal requirements:
 - a. one song in English
 - b. one song in a foreign language by a different composer
5. An accompanist will be available or you may provide your own. See the accompanist information sheet.
NO taped accompaniments allowed.
6. No music substitutions allowed.
7. There are no time limits.
8. Entrant must perform on the instrument studying in college.
9. Previous winners are encouraged to audition, however no student will be eligible to win 1st Place two years in a row.
10. Provide an original copy of required selections for the judges. Measure numbers should be marked.

As part of your scholarship acceptance, all recipients are required to participate in an informal celebratory recital for the Albert Lea Civic Music Board, parents, friends, and teachers at the end of the school year. Tentative recital date will be sent with your award.

Junior/Senior High Requirements

1. Please read all requirements carefully!
2. Entrant must live in the Albert Lea Civic Music selling area, (i.e. – approximately 30 mile radius of Albert Lea).
2. Each must perform two pieces of music contrasting style and period. Memorization is preferred, not mandatory.
3. An accompanist will be provided. NO taped accompaniments. See Accompanist information sheet.
4. No music substitutions allowed.
5. Total time limit is 12 minutes. To comply with time limits cut selections appropriately.
6. Entrant must perform on the instrument to be studied at music camp – no exceptions.
7. Previous winners are encouraged to audition, however no student will be eligible to win 1st Place two years in a row in the same age category.
8. Provide an original copy of required selections for the judges.
9. Measure numbers should be marked.

Scholarships are awarded for established music camps, NOT for private teachers or lessons.

For information on camps, check out the internet or local colleges. Scholarship must be used for established camp through college or other established organization.

As part of your scholarship acceptance, all recipients are required to participate in an informal celebratory recital for the Albert Lea Civic Music Board, parents, friends, and teachers at the end of the school year. Tentative recital date will be sent with your award.
